**Purpose:** The purpose of Quiet Time is to encourage the students to spend time building their relationship with the Lord.

The Quiet Time information is to be used each day. Check your group schedule for the scheduled time.

**Day 1:**

- Explain briefly the importance of spending time alone with the Lord each day. Because camp is a busy place, this is actually on our schedule. When the children return home from camp, they should continue to schedule a quiet time into their daily activities.
- Each student should be given a quiet time book and a pencil. Each day the “Quiet Time” pages will lead the children to read a few Bible verses and to pray. Have each student find a place where he/she can focus on the Lord. You may want to have each student sit on his/her bed or find a quiet place outside the cabin where the students can spread out.
- A guide should be available if the students need help or have questions. Some students will have a difficult time finding references in the Bible or have a different version of the Bible.

**Day 2-4:**

Continue to follow the schedule for quiet times. Remember to give each student a “Quiet Time” page/booklet and a pencil. Monitor the quiet time in case the students need help.

**Answer Key:**

The Answer key below is based on the New International Version of the Bible. Answers will vary when using other versions of the Bible. It is suggested that the guides work the quiet time pages before helping students complete the pages.




