

What to Bring To Camp:

Explorers Camp Theme Days:

Day 1: **Explorer/Tacky Hiker Celebration**

Day 2: **Christmas**

A Bible, pencils or pens.

2 Towels- 1 for a shower, 1 for the pool

Flip flops or sandals to go to the pool. Closed-toed shoes and maybe shower shoes too

Sunscreen, Sunglasses, Insect Repellant, and Flashlight

Toiletries – not the toilet, just your soap, shampoo, and deodorant too

Optional Blow Dryers, Curling Irons, or whatever makes you fluffed and buffed

Sleeping Bag / Single Size Sheets & Blanket, Pillow & pillowcase

Money to spend should be put on store cards –no cash, please.

Campers & Sponsors must dress appropriately.

All clothing should reflect modesty & discretion.

We ask you to inform everyone of the dress and weight codes before leaving for camp. It keeps everyone from getting upset when arriving at an event and being told they must make adjustments.

Closed-toed shoes are required for Recreation, Zipline, Adventure Course, and Bazooka Ball.

Short shorts and sleeveless shirts will not be allowed on the Zipline, Adventure Course, and Bazooka Ball.

If using the zip line, you must be at least **10** years old, and please note it has a 225lb weight limit.

Each person is taken privately to be weighed. When informing your attendees of the clothing requirements, you should convey the weight limit and age minimum as well.

A dark t-shirt must be worn at all times if wearing a two-piece swimsuit that does not touch or a one-piece with more cutouts than what's left.

Cover-ups will be worn to and from the swimming pool/waterfront (t-shirts for boys).

For the lake, you may bring your own coastguard-approved life vest. We provide them, and it is not required for you to bring your own. However, some people have felt more comfortable with their own.

While we hope God will reveal Himself to you during your stay, we prefer your clothes do not reveal yourself to us when participating in activities.
